



## AASECT Sexuality Educator Supervisor Supervision Contract Prototype

*Please note that this is just an example. Both parties to the supervision contract may add whatever additional language desired; however, the basic information below must be included.*

### AASECT Sexuality Educator Supervisor Supervision Agreement

This contract for the supervision of sexuality educator supervision will begin once the supervisee and supervisor sign a contract accompanied by supporting documents: supervisee. CV, transcript, proof of AASECT membership. The contract will remain in effect while the supervisee accrues fifteen (15) hours of supervision.

The AASECT Certified Supervisor will present to the Supervisee a copy of their current AASECT Educator Supervisor Certification certificate.

Both parties agree to keep the above documents current and active throughout the entire supervision process. If either party fails to keep these documents current, we agree to inform the other party immediately and in writing.

Both parties agree that PRIOR to commencement of individual or group supervision a Supervision Contract outlining the plan for supervision and signed by both Supervisor and Supervisee will be entered into.

The supervisee will keep a record of the supervision, and the supervisor will help the supervisee assemble all required documentation and oversee submission of the certification application. **Neither this contract, nor the completion of fifteen (15) hours of supervision, guarantee that the supervisee will be certified.** Ultimately it is the judgment of the supervisor to determine an applicant's readiness to submit an application for AASECT Certification. The AASECT Practitioner Supervisor Certification Committee determines eligibility and approval of the supervisee's certification application.

The supervisor and the supervisee will outline a mutually agreeable plan of supervision, which will improve the supervisee's skills to supervise sexuality educators to achieve the standard required for AASECT Sexuality Educator Supervisor Certification. They will also help them expand their sexological world views, increase their sexuality self-efficacy, increase their knowledge of sexuality knowledge and interventions, and improve their educational skills and perspectives.

The supervisee supervises educators working toward AASECT Certification. These educators will work to develop needs assessments, SMART learning objectives, lesson plans, evaluations, units of and entire curricula, workshops, and other teaching media. They teach individual students and community members who are interested in learning about human sexuality, sexual development, sexual culture and contemporary sexual issues. Supervision includes discussion of relevant theory and its application to supervision, of the supervisee's management of the supervisee's educational practices, development of resources and relevant literature. The supervisor will also monitor adherence to the Core Knowledge Areas, relevant skills, and *AASECT Code of Ethics*.

The methods of supervision may include face-to-face, telephone, audio/videotaping or some other platform of video conferencing. It will take place at either the supervisor's or supervisee's professional educational setting.

Both the supervisor and the supervisee will adhere to the *AASECT Code of Ethics*. Both will maintain ongoing AASECT membership, AASECT Sexuality Educator Certification. Additionally, the supervisor will maintain AASECT Sexuality Educator Supervisor Certification.

**The supervision contract may be terminated by either party with thirty (30) days' notice for any reason.**
